Innocent Transit Worker Fired by Guilty Bosses After Arbitration Hatchet Job

## Reinstate Train Operator Andy Valentine with Full Back Pay and a Clean Record!

In mid-April, Train Operator and TWU Local 100 member Andy Valentine was fired by the MTA after management conspired to make him take the blame and be their fall guy for the January 4, 2024 collision at 96th Street. What happened that day can only be described as an absolute safety meltdown and a glaring example of the MTA's priority of service over safety. The bosses set up Andy. Then he was made to eat it by the so-called "neutral" arbitrator, who wouldn't even allow the NTSB report which exonerates him into evidence. At the time of the collision, the Train Service Supervisor was operating the train, *not Andy*, who did everything in his power to communicate the imminent danger ahead and stop the train. An exemplary worker, Andy came back to work after a year, only to get fired by ass-covering management who *changed the rules* and railroaded him for procedures and practices that *didn't even exist* when the incident happened.

This outrage cannot go unanswered. If the MTA can dismiss a T/O like Andy Valentine, then we are all in danger.
